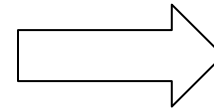
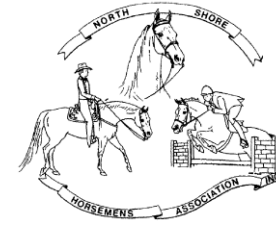

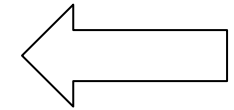

USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT
2010

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides provided the respective breed/discipline dues or breed/discipline category fee has been paid. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$20 nonmember registration fee and a \$5 breed/discipline category fee for each breed/discipline. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions; 8) Opportunity classes. 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

USEF FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees, and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors, and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of an in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable-casts, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR1502.5.

MOTORIZED VEHICLE STATEMENT

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of recognized competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

Fences 2'6". No restriction on rider or horse/pony.

MODIFIED ADULT HUNTER DIVISION

NEHC Rated "B"/MHC Rated "C"

\$20.00 per class/\$25 for stake class

Open to horses and ponies ridden by an Amateur Adult exhibitor. Rider/ horse combination may not enter any other rated Hunter division at same show. Fences not to exceed 2' 6"

2. MODIFIED ADULT HUNTER

3. MODIFIED ADULT HUNTER STAKE

\$20,\$15,\$12,\$10

4. LIMIT AM ADULT HUNTER SEAT EQUITATION OVER FENCES

Fences 2'3" to 2'6"

5. **GRANITE STATE ADULT MEDAL**, Fences not to exceed 2'9". Amateur riders 18 years of age and older must accumulate 12 points in order to qualify. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 8 fences with at least one change of direction. At least three (3) riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and is at the discretion of the judge. USEF Tests 1-18. Note: When a rider wins this medal class at year-end finals, he/she must skip one (1) year of competing in the class at the finals, but may return the following year.

6. MODIFIED ADULT HUNTER UNDER SADDLE

7. LIMIT AM ADULT HUNTER SEAT EQUITATION ON THE FLAT

8. OPEN EQUITATION – TO BE RUN ALL DAY

Fences 3'. No restriction on rider or horse/pony.

AMATEUR ADULT HUNTER DIVISION

USEF Rated "C" ~ NEHC/MHC Rated "A"

\$20.00 per class/\$25 for stake class

Fences not to exceed 3'0", spreads not to exceed fence height. To be ridden by Amateurs who are no longer eligible to compete as Junior exhibitors. Horse/rider combinations are not eligible for any other USEF/NEHC rated classes, except Adult Equitation and Pleasure classes. Horses may be shown by a different rider in any other division or class at this show. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners, way of going, size of rider to mount, and suitability as an Amateur Adult Hunter. Ponies may be ridden by adults, suitability to count.

Open to Amateur Adult members of MHC. All competitors are required to perform over at least 8 fences 2'6" to 2'9", with at least one change of direction. One or more individual tests of the top 4 competitors may be requested at the judge's discretion (USEF. tests 1-17). To fill a class, at least 4 competitors must complete the course.

13. **GRANITE STATE JUNIOR MEDAL** Fences not to exceed 3'. Junior riders must accumulate 12 points in order to qualify. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 8 fences with at least one change of direction. At least three (3) riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and is at the discretion of the judge. USEF Tests 1-18. Note: When a rider wins this medal class at year-end finals, he/she is no longer eligible to compete in this class and must move up to the Granite State Adult Medal once they reach the age requirement.

14. AMATEUR ADULT HUNTER SEAT EQUITATION ON THE FLAT NEHC "B"

19. NSHA SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION MEDAL (18")

Open to members of NSHA who are 12 years of age and under. Rider is not to compete in any other class that requires jumping fences any higher than 18". One or more tests of the top four competitors may be required at the discretion of the judge. The same horse must be used in all phases. Only one rider per horse. To fill the class, three riders must complete the course. The rider must be a member in order for points to count toward qualifying for the Finals. Rider must win one blue or accrue one blue.

20. **GRANITE STATE 18" NOVICE MEDAL**: Fences not to exceed 18" Junior and adult riders who have not shown over 18" at a recognized show must accumulate 12 points in order to qualify. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 8 fences with at least one change of direction. At least three (3) riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and is at the discretion of the judge. USEF Tests 1-18. Note: When a rider wins this medal class at year end finals, he/she is no longer eligible to compete in the class and must move up to the Granite State Children's Medal or the Granite State Modified Adult Medal depending upon riders age during the competition year.

CHILDREN'S HUNTER SEAT EQUITATION DIVISION

Open to exhibitors who are eligible for Children's Hunter and who have never shown over a course at a Recognized show where fences are required to exceed 3'0" at a Recognized Show. Fences for horses and large ponies to be 2'6" in height. Fences for small/medium ponies to be 2'0" in height

Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 8 fences with at least one change of direction. At least three (3) riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and is at the discretion of the judge. USEF Tests 1-18. Note: When a rider wins this medal class at year end finals, he/she is no longer eligible to compete in the class and must move up to the Granite State Junior Medal.

26. **GRANITE STATE PONY MEDAL**: Fences not to exceed 2'3" for small & medium ponies and 2'6" for large ponies. Junior pony riders must accumulate 12 points in order to qualify. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 8 fences with at least one change of direction. At least three (3) riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and is at the discretion of the judge. USEF Tests 1-18. Note: When a rider wins this medal class at year end finals two (2) consecutive years, he/she is no longer eligible to compete in the class and must move up to the Granite State Junior Medal.

27. MHC HUNT SEAT MINI-MEDAL

Open to Junior members of the MHC who have not reached their 15th birthday and have not competed in classes in which the entry is required to jump higher than 3'0". All competitors are to compete over a course not exceeding 8 fences and not less than 6, excluding combinations, at a height not to exceed 2'6". One or more individual tests may be requested at the judge's discretion (USEF tests 1-15). To fill a class at least 4 competitors must complete the course

33. NEHC HUNTER SEAT MEDAL

Open to Junior members of the New England Horsemen's Council who have not reached their 18th birthday. All competitors required to perform over at least 8 fences not exceeding 3'3". One or more individual tests of the top 4 competitors may be requested at judge's discretion (USEF tests 1-18). To fill a class, at least 4 competitors must complete the course.

37. SHOW CIRCUIT MAGAZINE CHILDREN'S MEDAL

Open to Junior members of the American Horse Shows Association or CEF who have never competed in a National Equestrian Final with fences at 3'6" (i.e.: USEF. Medal, ASPCA Maclay, USET, CET or CEF Finals, WIHS Capital Cup). All competitors are required to perform over at least 8 fences 2'9" to 3'0", spreads not to exceed fence height, with at least two changes of direction and a combination. The top 4 riders, or 20% of the first round competitors, whichever is greater, are required to perform at least two individual tests from USEF tests 1-19. An open numerical scoring system will be used in the first round.

38. PESSOA/USEF HUNTER SEAT MEDAL

Open to Junior members of the USEF who have not yet reached their 18th birthday. Fences not to exceed 3'6". Application for membership may be made through the Show Steward.

39. ASPCA HORSEMANSHIP

Open to Junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday. Fences not to exceed 3'6". A minimum of 12 riders, if available, are to show at a walk, trot, and canter, and shall count 50%. USEF tests 1-18. No participant may enter unless they are a Junior Patron, and must list their ASPCA number on their entry blank. Annual contribution to be \$15.00. Application to be made directly to the Horsemanship Dept., ASPCA, 441 East 92nd St., NY, NY10128

40. NEHC ENGLISH PLEASURE HORSE CLASS NEHC "C"

Open to all horses ordinarily used for pleasure purposes with no limitations as to the status of rider or place of residence. Shown at a walk, trot and canter. Horses will be required to back. Shall be judged on manners, performance, and quality. Loose rein on command of judge only, but without loss of contact.
